A Note from Our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

As we enter a new season of the church year, the season of Advent, we recognize that Advent has a distinctive place, for it calls us to prepare for the return of the Lord. It calls us to be looking to the "second coming" and the reign of God. Advent is about the future of the Risen One, who will judge all wickedness and prevail over every evil. It is the celebration of the promise that Christ will bring an end to everything that is opposing to the ways of God. Christ's resurrection is the first sign of this destruction of the powers of death, and now wait in anticipation of what is yet to come. Advent's pointing to the future, speaks to us right now.

And Christ's presence at Christmas commemorates the appearing of that Eternal Word in our midst. Christmas is about God taking on flesh, and God's divine participation in all that is painful, ugly, frustrating, and limited. God became like us that we might become like God, and God accepted death that the world might accept life. It's almost unbelievable that God would participate in, with, and for us, in all that we are and do, and yet this is truly the spirit of Christmas, and the awesome, overwhelming power of grace. God sent Jesus into the world to die on the cross not to "make a difference in the world," but to "make the world different." God came to us in Jesus, the Word made flesh, not to make adjustments and accommodations in the existing order of things, but to throw out the existing order and replace it with another.

God sent Jesus to redeem the world!

As Jesus' redeemed disciples, we too, are NOT sent out into the world, to just "make a difference in life," but to "make life different." And we can make life different! We can begin to make the world different by making ourselves different, by relying on God-provided insight and God- provided energy and courage to attempt the things that others say is impossible. If we truly want to be part of God's mission to redeem the world, we must get off that "make-a difference" diet and start stuffing our souls with God-sized dreams, the kind of dreams that truly create change, the kind of dreams we hear of around Christmas, like "Peace on earth, and goodwill to all."

So, as we enter into this busy season of Advent and Christmas, filled with all its commercialism and distractions, let us take the time this Advent season to slow down and reflect on how the coming of the Christ child changed the world, and how we can continue

his redeeming work. And don't forget to remember all those who may have experienced loss, who may find it difficult to experience the joy of this sacred season, and lift them up in prayer, visit them, listen to them, and encourage them with the hope only the Holy Spirit can bring. Allow this Advent season to be a break from all the busyness the world throws at us. Enter into the silence and hear the good news of the gospel. Let us direct our focus on the holy birth of the Christ child in Bethlehem, the promise of his coming again, and what we can do prepare the way of the Lord.



TAX TIME COMETH —

While we are still many months away from April 2025, the

end of the year is approaching rapidly. You may want to consider contributing some shares to Lutheran Church of the Holy Spirit. As you look toward the end of the year and the special needs of our church budget, you might consider the timeliness of certain contributions now.

Stocks that you have held for a long time and that have very low basis cost may be especially attractive as charitable gifts.

Stock gifts have double value because they often avoid capital gains tax and they result in an income tax deduction for charitable gifts.

Few people contribute to the church just for the tax advantages yet it is a consideration for when you might want to make a contribution.

Please be sure that if you make a transfer to the church, you notify our office so we can be sure all is completed in an orderly manner and proper credit is received.




