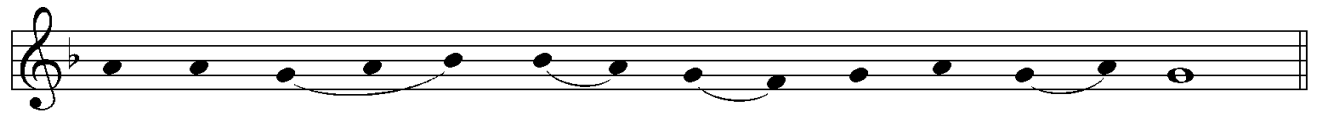
## THE GREAT THANKSGIVING



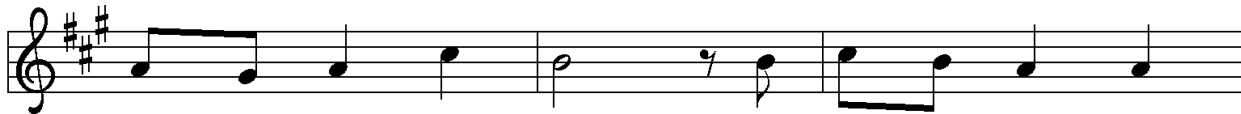
