A Note from Our Pastor

Dear friends in Christ,

As another school year begins and we celebrate the restart of many of our Christian Education programs, each year here at Holy Spirit, we rally together to celebrate Spirit Day. Spirit Day is a day to celebrate our many ministries and fellowship groups. It is a day to invite future members to join us in learning about what our church is all about and how we can be of service to them. And it is a homecoming for all our members to reacquaint themselves with their church family and commit to the ongoing growth and development of our ministries. Spirit Day is a day that will launch us into the many things that God has called us to for the coming school year.

And it is good for us to rally together, because our community needs us to be here for them. In a workshop I attended recently, our presenter discussed some of the research that Alban Institute has performed for churches and for the larger Christian community, and he identified that there are many people and families searching for answers that only the church can provide, and he divided these searchers into three categories. First of all, there are people searching for a church. There are over a million searches every month, by people who are searching for a church. That means, in every community there are people who already have a relationship with Christ and the Christian church, but who have just not yet found a church home. So, there are people in our community who fit that description, but may not have been invited to see what Holy Spirit offers.

The second type of searchers are people and families who are just looking for something to do. Many families will look for a family activity that they can engage in, to enjoy and participate together in, and therefore strengthen their own family relationships. Churches provide many of these type of healthy, nurturing, fun activities, like our Spirit Day, Trunk or Treat, Mardis Gras, and Easter Egg hunt. These are opportunities to build community, but also a way of inviting people into our own unique Christian family.

The third type of seekers are people in search of hope. These are people in need of ministry, who may be experiencing a challenge in their life and don't know where to turn. Perhaps they are new to the area and have had a hard time getting to know people or how to access the resources that are available to them. They may be experiencing loss, a medical problem, a change in employment, and are having a hard

time coping with their distress. In a society where we, as individuals, are supposed to be able to solve whatever problem comes our way, many live in isolation and feel lost and forgotten. And this is where a church community can provide so much love and support. By praying for our brothers and sisters in need, we can bring Christ into their lives and provide the support and faith that only God can give.

In the coming months I look forward to our developing how our church reaches out to the seekers in our community, and how we can welcome them to Holy Spirit. It's wonderful to see how our church is growing, but there is an even greater need that we need to be aware of and we need to address. So, as we celebrate another new beginning and another Spirit Day, let us also look forward to how Christ may be using us in the coming year to build His Church. And may we all be a part of it.

In October, we will pack "treat boxes" for our college students as they





ENDOWMENT COMMITTEE UPDATE

During the July Endowment Committee meeting, the committee approved funding in the amount of \$13,237, which included amounts for the deductible for insurance claim for lightning strike, parking lot sealing and striping, sanctuary sound updates, outdoor sound system and a contribution for the Synod for continuing education.

After 25 years as a member and leader of the Endowment Committee, Ken Rosco has decided to retire from his role with the committee. We thank Ken for all his years of dedication and hard work establishing the endowment fund and being an integral part of this important committee since 1998. At the August 14 Church Council meeting, members voted to approve the nominations of Larry Brady, Barry Nelson, and Jerry Mason to fill vacancies on the committee.

The purpose of the Endowment fund is to expand the benevolent mission of the congregation apart from the general operation of the congregation. Contributions to the endowment fund are accepted as a cash contribution, and also from bequests in wills and trusts. Please consider the Lutheran Church of the Holy Spirit Endowment Fund as part of your annual giving and also in your final estate planning.

HIGHLIGHTS

The monthly Church Council meeting was held on August 14th. Treasurer's report included monthly Benevolence offerings and other income of \$40,362. (YTD total is \$244,315). Operating expenses were \$41,286 (YTD total is \$270,964). As of the end of May, we have a negative operating budget deficit of \$26,648.

Pastor's report Pastor Tim reported that he has met with the Korean Vision Church and they are considering renting our church for their services. He also attended a workshop on church growth. The program is available for purchase. Council will look into the program. Christian Education will begin Sunday School on September 17 th and LYFE will begin on August 29 th. Human Needs will be collecting donations to help Fill a Heart 4 Kids supply backpacks and school supplies to homeless and foster youth. Property reported the parking lot has been resurfaced and restriped. The floors will be stripped and waxed August 14-16. The next work day is scheduled for August 19th . Worship and Music will be meeting to map out the new year. Long Range Planning will be putting together a task force to construct a vision for the church.

Old Business: The Endowment Committee made a donation to help with several needs around the church. The Narthex was recently painted by Jean Gates and the new furniture pieces are ready to be delivered. **New Business:** Council approved the appointment of Jackie Murphy as the new Fellowship Chair. Council also approved three new members on the Endowment Committee. The new members are Larry Brady, Jerry Mason, and Barry Nelson. **Next council meeting currently is scheduled for September 11th, at 7:30 PM**. All council meetings are open to Holy Spirit members. Minutes and reports of the council are kept in a public notebook in the narthex.

Quilters — The quilting ministry meets on the third Tuesday of each month at 10:00. This months date is Aug 15th. No experience necessary to join them.

Prayer Group — Our prayer group meets at 9:30 AM every Thursday morning in the Sanctuary as we lift up those in need of prayer. Everyone is welcome to join us.


