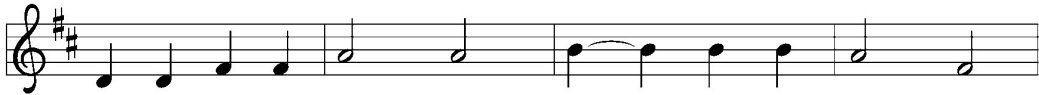

Genesis 1:1–2:4a

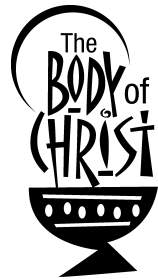
WORDS OF INSTITUTION

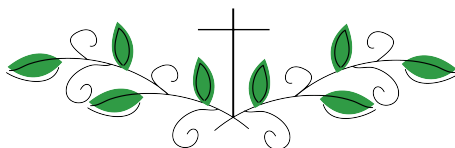
