# A Note from Our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ.

Many of us were still grieving, over the senseless mass shooting in the Uvalde Texas elementary school, before the wave of violence came to our own neighborhood. Who could have imagined that on a beautiful summer day where a community gathered together for a parade to celebrate our nation and all that we share together, to share all that unites us as we strive for life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness; that our community would be traumatized by a young man with a weapon of war. Our hearts are heavy for the families of the seven who were killed in Highland Park, and the dozens of others who were injured, and we pray for healing and justice in the face of this massacre. And we pray that a tragic event like this will never happen again, and that all who might consider such an act of violence might receive the help and intervention that they need. We pray that all can live in harmony, security, and peace.

As I was contemplating what we could do put an end to the violence and bring people together to work toward common goals and just solutions, and acknowledge that every person is valuable in the eyes of God, I was reminded of a well-known story.

While Jesus was traveling, he stopped by a well to take a rest while his disciples went into town to get some food. A woman came to draw out some water, and Jesus asked her for a drink. Now there were a lot of reasons why Jesus and this woman should never have had a conversation; they were of rival nations, there were societal rules that prevented men and women from socializing, Jesus was a respected teacher, and the woman was of ill repute having already had five marriages and was now living with another man. And their religious beliefs were not very respectful of each other either. And yet the two have a conversation, and Jesus offers the woman living water, and the woman replies, "Sir, give me this water, so that I might never be thirsty again." Despite their differences, the woman's thirst leads her to bring others to the well too. She went back to the city and said to anyone who would listen, "Come and see a man who told me everything I have ever done! He couldn't be the Messiah, could he?" Without telling them what to believe, but by just echoing the great door-opening Gospel invitation, "Come and See", Jesus transforms this woman, this despised outcast of society, and she becomes the first person to preach Jesus as the Messiah.



Perhaps salvation from God does not depend so much on getting everything right as much as it depends on our thirst, our thirst for that life-transforming living water.

There are many who are busy going about their day-to-day lives, who are searching for answers, who are struggling to get through the day, or, who may be comfortable, yet feel incomplete. There are many who are thirsty for Jesus. Having drunk from His life-giving water, let's share what we know and the impact of Jesus in our lives. Who knows what miracles God may work through us and our efforts, and yet we can be sure that Christ's life-giving water will nourish us and sustain us no matter what we may do. So, let's invite others to "Come and See," a community of believers devoted to serving God, and let's share our faith with others, for our cups are overflowing in a world dying of thirst.
